ORDINANCE NO. 2014-03

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 11-2-1(e) AND 11-2-13 OF THE VILLAGE OF FREDONIA CODE OF ORDINANCES PERTAINING TO THE PHOHIBITION OF HUNTING AND THE THROWING OR SHOOTING OF MISSILES AND PROJECTILES WITHIN THE VILLAGE OF FREDONIA AND

The Village Board of the Village of Fredonia does ordain as follows:

Section 11-2-1 (e) is hereby amended to read as follows:

(e) **Hunting Prohibited.** Discharging a firearm or bow and arrow while hunting is prohibited within the corporate limits of the Village of Fredonia.

Section 11-2-13 is hereby amended to read as follows:

Village Clerk

Throwing or Shooting of Arrows, Stones, and Other Missiles and Projectiles Prohibited.

A. Except as provided in Subsection B hereof, no person shall throw, or shoot or propel any object, arrow, stone, snowball, or other missile or projectile by hand or by any other means or mechanism at any person, building or other object within the Village of Fredonia, corporate boundaries provided the Board may issue permits to an organized archery club or an archer to engage in target practice within the Village at times and places designated by the Village Marshal. Archery courses approved and sponsored by the local public or private schools and property supervised may be granted a temporary variance from this Ordinance, provided that the Village Marshal grants such a written temporary variance permit for a period not to exceed the then school term, or then length of approved course, whichever be the shorter period of time.

- <u>B. A person may hunt with a bow and arrow or crossbow within the Village, subject to the following restrictions:</u>
 - (1) No such hunting is permitted on public property.
 - (2) No such hunting is permitted within 100 yards of any building used for human occupancy located on another person's land unless the person who owns the land on which the building is located allows the hunter to hunt within 100 yards of the building.
 - (3) No such hunting is permitted unless the arrow or bolt is discharged toward the ground.

	This ordinance shall take effect and be in force one day after its passage and posting as provided by law.
