- 1. **Call meeting to order** Called to Order by Chairman Gehrke at 7:00PM. Village President Dohrwardt and Trustee Paape in attendance.
- 2. Approve minutes from the November 30, 2022, Parks and Recreation Committee meeting Motion to Approve by Dohrwardt, 2nd by Paape. Approved Unanimously.
- 3. **Movie: NOSD** Movie night set for February 9th at 7PM at the Commons area at Northern Ozaukee School District Campus showing "Clifford". Tap into school groups to for concessions.
