New Inter-municipal Agreement



The Town of Fredonia has joined a inter-municipal agreement with the Villages of Fredonia, Belgium, and Town of Belgium to create a Joint ALS-Paramedic Level service. This service will be managed and contracted out by the Village of Fredonia to provide paramedic-level services to the Northern Ozaukee area. This program is funded for the

first 3 years through an Ozaukee County grant program, and will increase the level of service provided to area residents and shorten response times overall.

From the Fire Chief

As we look ahead to spring, please be mindful of a few fire safety tips to help keep you, your family and your property safe.



Please exercise extreme caution if or when burning outside. During this time of year, even with the ground being soft and wet, grasses and brush can be extremely dry and make for a good fuel if ignited. Winds are usually a bit stronger too which enhances the drying process, but can also push and feed a fire to the point of being out of control. Avoid any burning when there is a significant amount of wind. Wind direction can change instantly and without warning, taking what might be a small controlled fire and turning it into a large, frenzied and highly unsafe situation. If you have doubts about burning, don't burn. If you have questions about if you should burn or not, please contact us, we'll be glad to answer any questions you may have. As always, prior to any burning, notify the Waubeka Fire Department (262)692-2656 and the Ozaukee County Sheriff's Department (262)284-7172.

Spring is also a good time for getting out the grill and enjoying some cooking in the outdoors. A few guidelines for you to follow can make for a safe grilling season. Start out with a clean grill, free of grease or food buildup. Always use the grill outside and away from your home, garage, eaves or overhanging branches. Never leave it unattended and keep children and pets away while it is in use. For charcoal grills, do not use gasoline, kerosene, or any other flammable fluids to light the coals –only use a charcoal starter fluid. Always keep the starter fluid, and matches, out of the reach of children and away from heat sources. Wait until coals are completely cooled then dispose of them in a metal container. For propane grills, check the fuel line prior to the first use. Spray the hose with a soap/ water solution to check for any potential leaks. If you see bubbles in the hose after turning the gas on, there is most likely a leak that will need to be addressed prior to using it.



Waubeka Historic District Update

Waubeka Historic District Association is a group of community members seeking to raise the adequate funds to conduct the process to nominate Waubeka as a Historic District in the State of Wisconsin. Doing so would ensure a revival and sustainability of the community and note its historical mark in the early days of the state of Wisconsin. Klessig's Riverside Group LLC owner of Klessig's Cheese factory and Charles Sheridan owner of the Button Factory, both financially pitched in to invite the Wisconsin State Historic Preservation Officer to review Waubeka. It's history and a first hand walk among its streets determined the time period for the historical district nomination, which would be between 1870 and 1890. After 1890 Waubeka's industry, bit by bit faded as the train station settled in the Village of Fredonia and younger people moved away for work outside of Waubeka. The money we hope to raise will cover the professional research of the buildings and report needed to make the case Waubeka should be designated a Historic District. Klessig's Riverside Group LLC and Bidinger Haus LLC have individually paid for their buildings to be researched.

The community should be aware, becoming a Historic District has zero restrictions on the buildings within the Historic District. The reason for Waubeka to become a Historic District is to provide the ability to revive and sustain the historic buildings, showcasing it's history. Waubeka is unlike other Ozaukee County communities because we are not peppered with modern day structures. We're a treasure which can benefit from being listed as a Wisconsin Historic District. And it's an honor to have the potential to be considered!

In 2023 the Waubeka Historic District Association will be hosting various fundraiser activities to reach our goal of \$22,000.
