Possible Application for a Certified Survey Map & Rezone by LeAnne Dieringer: Ms. Dieringer presented a proposal to subdivide her late father, Roy Rau's, farmstead at W4138 River Park Road. The merits of the proposed 3, 20-acre parcels were discussed by the commission and there was consensus to have Ms. Rau proceed with her subdivision. No further action was taken.

Application for a Conditional Use Permit by Robert Wagner: Mr. Wagner presented a final draft of the CUP for Retail car sales in Agricultural District. A motion to recommend approval the final CUP by the Town Board was made by D. Winquist; second by C. Janik: carried 6-1, S. Jentges-Nay.

Application for a Condition Use Permit at W3110/W3116 Belgium Kohler Road, by Kim Gentz: Mr. Ryan Mueller, agent and contractor for Mr. Gentz was present to answer questions of the Plan Commission, on the final draft CUP to allow a duplex in commercial zoning. Mr. Mueller presented a proposed parking plan for the duplex. This plan only allowed for 1 parking space and it was recommended that the parking move to the east side of the Duplex along STH 57, where there is more room for 4 vehicles (2 per residence). A motion to recommend the CUP to the Town Board for approval was made by S. Paulus; second by S. Jentges; carried.

Renewal of Conditional Use Permit for American Tower Corp (ATC) for Aerial Tower: The final draft of the CUP renewal of the ATC Tower at N6628 State Road 57 was presented. B. Koeppen presented a list of issues with the site that need to be addressed prior to issuance of the renewal. Clerk Eichner will forward these concerns to ATC. A motion to recommend approval of the renewal to the Town Board was made by S. Paulus; second by D. Winquist; carried, L. Leider abstained.
