Presentation of a conceptual plan for a Certified Survey Map & Rezone by Quam Engineering: The Commission was presented with a conceptual plan for a proposed land division, creating 4 lots and zoning change (from A-1 to R-2 and R-3) at W4318 River Park Road. During discussions, it was learned that an additional 5-acre lot will need to be added on the northwest corner of the property. The Commission would also prefer to see as rectangular lots as possible. Quam Engineering will return for the October 7<sup>th</sup> Plan Commission meeting with a draft CSM and soil borings for developable lots. No further action was taken

Application for a zoning variance by Tony A. Roy: Mr. Roy has requested a zoning variance for the height of a proposed accessory building at W3565 Belgium Kohler Road. Mr. Roy has a smoker used in his catering business that has a high smokestack which requires a twelve-foot-high garage door which will require a roof peak of 19 feet. After discussion, a motion to deny the variance and send the matter to the zoning Board of Appeals was made by C. Janik; second by B. Koeppen; passed. The Board of Appeals was set for Wednesday, September 30, 2020 at 7:00pm.
